



FAQs AIR-board® Decorative Cladding Panels

- 1 Can 'Air board' product be used for doors and partitions for a single residential project?**

- 2 What thicknesses are available for AIR-board®?**

- 3 Does it comply with fire safety requirements for residential projects?**
The polycarbonate ones do meet BCA. Acrylic will meet it because they are not a fixed wall.
- 4 Can AIR-board® be sealed at the edges to avoid adding a perimeter trim or frame?**
Yes ,we can fabricate in house an edge with the same colour as the cover sheets.
- 5 Can Air-board® be rebated at the bottom edge to receive a floor guide? For example: 8 mm x 16mm rebate?**
After edging all round we can glue another strip on the base to act as a guide for the track.
- 6 Can the AIR-board® be screw fixed for mounting to a sliding door track without the need for a perimeter frame?**
The joiners must ensure the holes that we have drilled or machined have a plastic or S/Steel bush to prevent stress from the bolt or hardware for the door on the hole.
- 7 Can AIR-board® be scratched? How does it compare in durability with laminates?**
It can be scratched with intention. It has the same surface hardness as Aluminium. The frosted and lighter colours will not show scratches due to the textures.
- 8 How can AIR-board® be cleaned?**
We have plastic cleaners *bottles and aerosol cleaners available, and do not use chemicals.
